It was quickly decided a name was needed for this body of shooters. After researching the archives, it was discovered that a wagon train of Marshall, MI residents in 1849 was headed to the gold fields of California using the name of Wolverine Rangers. In as much as those pioneering residents were embarking on a new course of action, it is fitting and appropriate that the cowboy action shooters of Michigan carry on with the name Wolverine Rangers in their pioneering adventure.

We are a non-profit organization that originated in 1997 and have a membership of 200+ from Michigan, Ohio and Canada. We have 15 Cowboy Action Shooting clubs participating so there is sure to be one in your neck of the woods.

The Wolverine Rangers embrace the rules of SASS (Single Action Shooting Society) and encourage Cowboy Action Shooters to join SASS. SASS is an international organization created to preserve and promote the sport of Cowboy Action Shooting.
