Updated Range War Information – 8-28-2020

There have been a number of questions that have come up with regards to the plans and procedures for Range War 2020. Please see the outline of information in this document for the latest info. Note, some restrictions are out of our control and are being updated regularly. We are following these to the best of our ability.

Please remember that COVID-19 is affecting how things are done in every aspect of our day to day lives. While the information below is what we have planned under the current State of Michigan Executive Orders, these orders are subject to change and have been changing weekly if not more often. That being said there are restrictions in place now that may not be in place in September. There may also be more restrictions that are added that could change how we move forward. As these restrictions change, we will continue to monitor and address them as necessary up until the start of the event.

As of the date of this letter Executive Order 2020-160 is still in effect. This order states that St. Clair county falls within Region 1. Region 1 is declared to be in Stage 4 of the Michigan Safe Start Plan. During stage 4, Region 1 is limited to outdoor gatherings and events of up to 100 people, and states that those not of the same household maintain 6 ft social distancing from one another. General range info

- O All registered shooters have been sent confirmations and a copy of this letter.
- We are requesting that opening ceremonies be limited to shooters only.
- Once complete and we break to head into the range your non-shooting guest may safely proceed to your shooting bay. Each posse has ~ 15 shooters, we are suggesting we have no more than 20 people per bay.

Registration

- O Masks or face coverings (covering mouth and nose) will be required during registration. We will have a safe procedure in place for interactions. If you arrive without a mask, we will have disposable masks available for use. Our volunteers will not be able to serve you without one. This is the only time at the range that we will mandate wearing of masks.
- New this year We will be able to accept credit cards at registration and at the awards dinner for raffle tickets. (processed securely through Square)
- O Each shooters packet will be full of items this year.
- Our registration volunteers will review your packet with you and pass out any refunds due or collect and funds due before you leave registration.
- O We will have items for sale as well
 - T-shirts and Towels from years past

- T-shirts and towels from 2020
- Wolverine Rangers, Wolverine Rangers 2020 and Range War 2020 logo stickers.
- Wolverine rangers 2020-2021 calendars
- As well as a couple of our surprise items.

• Side Matches

- o If you are shooting any of the mini matches your posse number will be provided to you at registration.
- Please remember that the AM mini matches for Cowboy and Wild Bunch have a mandatory safety meeting at 8:45 AM on Friday morning on the range.
- New this year we will be scoring the cowboy mini matches, both AM and PM.
 Categories will be Ladies and Men's. Places will be awarded up to five places deep.

• Saturday Night Dinner

- o The Saturday Night Dinner will be cancelled this year.
- O Very few people signed up for this event. Not enough to have a dinner.
- o For those people that paid for this dinner you will have the option to either receive a refund or raffle tickets for the raffle prize drawings.

• Cowboy Church

• We are looking for someone to volunteer to lead this year's church.

• Sunday Night Banquet and Awards

- The banquet facility will continue to be closed and is not be an option for providing diner this year.
 - Good news is that we were able to secure the facility for 2021!
- o The awards will be presented before and/or after dinner under the tents.
- o The awards presentation will follow SASS Covid-19 guidelines.
- o Additional port-johns will be stationed near the tents to keep everyone comfortable during the awards and dinner.
- o Two hand washing stations will be located near the tents.
- o Bottled water will be provided.
- o Dinner Updates:
 - We have found a local chef and catering company that has come to us highly recommended in the area.
 - They will be providing dinners for all shooters.
 - They will also be providing dinners for all additional guests that prepurchased guest banquet tickets.
 - Dinners will be served as individual meals. No handling of food will be done on-site. It will be safely handled. Silverware will be included in the packaging.
 - Dinners will include:
 - Either Marinated Pasta Salad or Creamy Coleslaw
 - o Half will be with pasta the other half will be coleslaw.
 - Oven Roasted Chicken
 - BBQ Pulled Pork Sandwich

- TexMex Baked Beans
- Herb Roasted Potatoes
- Rolls and Butter
- & a Double Chocolate Brownie
- There will be plenty of room to spread out in the tent area. Please do so per social distancing recommendations.
- o Disinfecting wipes, sprays and cleaners will be available for use at your table.
- o Hand sanitizer will also be available throughout the tent area.
- We will set up additional pop-up tents to place the dinners in for pickup.
- o More pop-up tents will be used for the awards area.
- We have secured a professional DJ to have his equipment on site for the dinner and awards ceremony. This will provide ample sound so that everyone will be able to hear the awards presentation.

• Main Match

- o Per SASS Covid-19 guidelines:
 - All Timer Operators will be required/suggested to wear masks/facial coverings while operating the timer.
 - Disinfectant spray or wipes will be provided at each stage for cleaning the timer at handoff to the next TO.
 - It is recommended that no more than two scorekeepers are to be used per posse. Cleaning products will be provided for handoff to the next scorekeeper.
 - Social distancing should be followed.
- o Posse sizes will be 15-16 people to keep the size small but still be manageable.
 - Posse lists will be posted at Registration
- Stages have been posted on our website.
 - Thank you for the feedback so far on them.
 - We have marked up each individual shooter's handbooks with the minor typos that have been found.
- o Round Count will be 100 pistol, 101 rifle and 40+ shotgun for the main match.
- There will not be Brass Rats this year. Please take the time to pick brass on your posse. This is not a lost brass match.

Golf Carts

- o All golf carts are paid for and accounted for.
- We may have one available if someone needs to request one. Please call me if you would like to discuss this possibility.

Door Prizes and Raffle prizes

- We have had many generous donors this year for our prizes.
- A list that was current as of the printing of the shooter's handbook is printed in the book. A complete list will be available at registration and dinner for you to review.
- o At this time, we have close to 150 prizes to hand out.
- o Smaller value items will be part of our door prize raffle.
 - You will get a ticket at registration to drop in the box for a chance to win these items.

- Winners will be drawn Saturday night and these prizes will be available for pick up or handed out during the awards dinner.
- o Large value items will be part of our raffle
 - Tickets will be sold at registration and at the awards dinner
 - Payment can be by cash or credit card.
 - Tickets will be \$5 each or 5 for \$20
 - There are some very nice items here, including a custom Doc Noper Belt and Holsters set.
- We also have one surprise item we will raffle off in a special way during dinner. It is a really great item.
