They have both worked hard, did a very nice job and are deserving of our thanks and appreciation. I would also like to thank Card Shark Charlie and Lainey Mae for the work which they have done in handling a lot of the administrative duties regarding membership for the past few years. 
DSC-Rocky River Regulators
