Howdy Tex and Hipshot,

I wanted to let you know that the Wolverine Rangers, the organization of the 15 Cowboy Action Shooting Clubs in the state of Michigan, has recently completed the steps necessary for us to have the capability to accept on-line registration for the SASS Michigan State Championship of Cowboy Action Shooting (Wolverine Rangers' Range War - August 31st thru September 2nd). We also have the capability to accept payment by credit card via PayPal or with a PayPal account. The links are identified below. We are already accepting on-line registration for Range War via this process. I was the first one to use it and it is very quick, easy, and user friendly. I would highly recommend that other big matches consider implementing on-line signup. Most Cowboy Action Shooters are now computer literate (although some of us have had to be dragged into it and in some cases kicking and

screaming). This eliminates the normal practice of having shooters manually fill out the application form and then writing a check and sending everything via snail mail. This also makes it easier for the club running the shoot because it eliminates a lot of the paper handling that comes with receiving applications and checks via the mail.

thank my T would like to daughter Cosmopolitan Christine (SASS# 89401 -Emily Kucinich) the Secretary for the Wolverine Rangers, for taking the initiative and getting this done for us. I would not have had a clue on how to do it. I would also like to thank Laporte Lil (SASS # 33413) our webmaster for making the appropriate changes to our website to allow shooters access the online application and payment through our website. She is the best webmaster in the business.

All payments will be made through PayPal and registrants will receive a confirmation of payment from PayPal in addition to a registration confirmation from the Wolverine Rangers.

The one issue which we do not have a good handle on at this time is what the total cost will be for using the on-line registration and payment through PayPal. We pay 2.9% plus .30 per transaction. Our treasurer Snareman (SASS #21425) estimates that the cost will run about \$650 for Range War. This will of course depend on how many shooters avail themselves of the on-line registration and payment through PayPal. The advantage is that it is very shooter friendly and there is significantly less paper work and manual work by having everything done on-line when compared to manually opening the mail with the shooter applications and then inputting everything into the computer. It will be a lot easier from an administrative standpoint for the clubs putting on the bigger matches. I will submit a report to both of you after Range War to let you know how it worked out.

By the way, we would love to have either of you (or both) and/or any other Wild Bunch member come to Michigan for Range War this year over Labor Day weekend.

There are two new SASS recognized age categories. Cattle Baron, men 75 and older and Baroness, women 75 and older. Shooters may register in these categories for Range War 2012.

SPORTING CLAYS AVAILABLE AT FENTON

the Fenton Lakes Sportsman's Club board of directors has approved a proposal to let cowboys shoot the sporting clays range after Butcher Butte matches for \$13 per 50 bird round instead of the usual \$18. 
