Johnson Creek Regulators - Plymouth

The JCR crew is making a few changes for 2019. Slow Gin Rickey (formerly known as Panhead Pete) and William "Kid" Henry have taken over JCR's reins as Sheriff and Deputy for the season.

Next, the JCR gang will be offering a side match at each monthly match. The side match is included in the match fee. Winner of the side match wins a free match (limit one per competitor during the season).

Finally, in an effort to bring back experienced competitors, the JCR gang is going to run a "Limited Mobility" match in July. The Limited Mobility Match will be a challenge for all Cowboys, but will minimize movement. One or two stages will require all Cowboys to shoot from a seated position, but it will be an option on every stage. In addition, we will be making some changes to the range layout to minimize travel distances on the range.

On April 27th twenty shooters enjoyed a bright sunny spring day for the opener of the 2019 Cowboy season with the Johnson Creek Regulators with stages designed by Slow Gin Ricky. We can only surmise that the forecast for a late spring snow storm kept the crowd down.

We led off with a bang with our first side match. The key to winning the side match was a combination of speed and accuracy with pistol and shotgun. Sarge won the side match with engaging a pistol and shotgun knockdown target in 4.74 seconds.

Wolverine Regulator left everyone else riding drag in the Main match with a fine corrected time of 146.66 seconds. Rev Miss A Lot was second with an adjusted time of 161.50. Mishomis and Dead Eye Deska scored the only clean matches of the day.

Our next match is Saturday May 18. Hope to see everyone there.

PLYMOUTH ANNOUNCEMENT - Howdy from Plymouth. We are going to have our first match of the season on April 27th. We are going to feature a free side match at every match this year. They will be low round count, maybe 2 firearms at a time. For example, one pistol and one shotgun, best time wins, 5 seconds added for a miss, only 2 shotgun shells allowed to knock it down. The winner wins a free match. Although you can participate in every side match, you can only win once. We are working on an exploding bonus target. We hope to have it ready for April. Our July match will be a "Limited Mobility" match. We want to accommodate cowboys and cowgirls who are wheelchair bound or have difficulty moving during a stage. Every stage will be shot from one position with 2-3 stages having everyone shoot from the seated position.
