If you are not a member this is a great time to join as you will then shoot the match for free and be entered into the raffle. After lunch and the results, we will hold our annual membership meeting in the clubhouse. Make sure you stay for the meeting and raffle giveaways.

Range War 2021 will be held at Bluewater Sportsman's Association in Kimball, MI on Sept.  $3^{rd} - 5^{th}$ , 2021. There are no restrictions this year for the number of entries, we will be fully open to all those that register. Alexander's banquet facility is excited to have us back for Sunday dinner and awards.

We are excited to be open to all shooters again this year. We also plan to welcome our Canadian pards as the border should be open by then. End of Trail 2021, the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary, was held in Etna Green, IN at Paradise Pass from June 18<sup>th</sup>-26<sup>th</sup>. This was the first time in the history of SASS that this event was held east of the Mississippi. The Paradise Pass crew transformed their home range into a world class event. Misty Moonshine and Ruby Ruthless worked nonstop to make this event perfect, they really deserve some time off. There were plenty of vendors to fill your cowboy needs. Those vendors included our own Steady Eddie and JJ Hunter. Many pictures were posted to our Wolverine Rangers Facebook page, stop in and take a look.

EOT started with three days of the Wild Bunch Action Shooting World Championships. This was a challenging match with an array of small to large targets set near and far. The warmup day featured three stages and the WBAS speed side matches. The 12-stage main match was over two days, six stages per day. There were no clean matches in Wild Bunch. As it turned out these were the hottest days of the week with high humidity and temperatures in the 90's. There were seven Rangers that shot this match.

I was selected for the Top Eight Top Gun Shoot Off, which was an amazing experience to be in front of the crowd Saturday Morning, prior to the EOT Cowboy Awards ceremony. I have watched these shoot offs before but have never been a finalist like this. Ethan Callahan was also selected as an alternate, but unfortunately all of the top eight were there. Although I shot pretty well, I ended up spraining my ankle during the shoot and ultimately lost to Don Jorge who was the overall shoot off champion.

After Wild Bunch was over the Cowboy Action began. Two days of warm up and side matches and followed by 12-stages over three days. The weather was hit and miss. It rained a little every day, and it rained a lot many days as well. The vendors area was in a mini lake by Friday and Saturday. We had 34 Rangers compete in the Cowboy Match.
