General Rangers Info:

Free Membership Shoot:

This year our annual free shoot and membership meeting will take place at DSC (Utica) on July 16^{th} . The Rocky River Regulators will have a fun five stage match set up. After the match we will put on lunch and our annual meeting. As per the last few years we will review our financials, upcoming Range War info, Shootout at Bloody Porch info, our Clean Shooter awards and finish up with some prize drawings. We will need to plan for a head count this year as we will need to decide if we can have the meeting inside the cowboy building, or if we will need to hold it in the main clubhouse.

Range War:

Info and Events Schedule: The general information sheet flyer and schedule of events will be posted by June 14th.

Stage writing contest: We are inviting everyone to submit their favorite stage for consideration in this year's match. This can be a stage you love, one that you enjoyed at a previous Range War, or just one that you thought up that you would like to shoot. These can be submitted via email, mail, text or in person to Sinola Kid. Entries will be accepted now through June 15th, 2023. Our range committee will review all entries and select ten stages for the 2023 Range War. It has been brought to my attention that some may not want their name associated with the stage. If this is the case and you would still like to submit a stage, please do so, and let me know you would prefer to stay anonymous. We have had quite a few submissions, but we would still like more.

Stage Sponsorship: So far, we have three stage sponsors, and we are looking for seven more. Each stage sponsor will receive advertising/recognition space in the shooter's handbook as well as signage on the stage. Sponsorships will start at a recommended donation of \$100 per stage. We will use these funds to update our props, tables, and feel of the stages. Of course, we are open to suggestions as well for improvements. If you are interested in sponsoring a stage this year, please contact me to discuss by July 1st, as we need time to get the book updated.

Mustache Kid finished 3rd in Silver Senior and 17th overall. Crazy Mingo finished 1st in Frontier Cartridge and 39th overall, also he was first in his category in the Wild Bunch mini match. JR Hammer finished 1st in El Patron and 48th overall.

Just be sure to bring eye and hearing protection.
