Other Rangers info to think about this winter:

- 1) Elections for 2024
 - a. In November we will start taking nominations for our elections in December.
 - b. Watch our website for notifications on when the nominations are open.
 - c. Our First Lieutenant and Treasurer positions will be voted on
 - i. These are both a two-year term.
 - d. We have up to eight members at large positions that can be voted on. i. These are for a one-year term.
 - e. Nominations are required and the nominee must accept the nomination.
 - f. All nominees must be current Wolverine Rangers members, and must renew for 2024-2025.
- 2) Winter Board of Directors meeting
 - a. The board will be notified of the time and place for the winter board meeting via email.
 - b. This meeting will be our annual end of year debrief, Range War, Bloody Porch and our general membership and financial report to date.
 - c. Will be held in Late November or December.
- 3) Club Contacts for 2024
 - a. Each club will need to let Carolina Belle know of any contact changes for the website and calendar for the 2024-2025 season by January 1st
- 4) Calendar Dates, Info and Photos
 - a. All scheduled shoot dates for 2024-2025 will need to be submitted to Carolina Belle by January 1st.
 - b. Any changes to fees, times, contact information, etc. will need to be submitted as well by January 1st.
 - c. While we take lots of pictures each year, we prefer that each club email in pictures from their shoots. These are for the calendar pages and the more pictures the merrier. Please submit via email to Carolina Belle by January 1st.
- 5) There are a few clubs that have winter shoots, Lapeer, Hillman, and Washtenaw.
 - a. Please check the website for dates and any last-minute changes, due to inclement weather.

Other Rangers info to think about this winter (continued): 6) Wolverine Rangers Free Shoot in 2024 a. The Rangers free shoot and annual membership meeting will be on Sunday June 23rd in Plymouth. b. The second annual Annie Oakley Ladies only shoot will be on Saturday June 22nd in Plymouth. c. This will make this a two day shoot for some, more info to come. Camping onsite will be available for those that would like to make a weekend out of it. 7) Membership, Range War and Bloody Porch online applications. a. I am currently testing programs to replace our online application process. The program we have used for years has increased in cost by ~350% in the last year. As we continue to maintain a balanced budget, we need to reduce this cost. Another program is the only option. b. Once I determine which program is going to work the best for us, I will roll it out to start with the membership applications for 2024-2025. I expect this to go live by January 1st, 2024. c. Next will be the Range War and Bloody Porch applications. Range War apps will also go live on January 1st. With Bloody Porch applications to be available by January 15th, 2024. Lastly, I want to remind everyone about the classified section of our website. There is plenty of good gear listed for sale. Note, if you're looking to buy or sell on the classifieds, any firearms must follow state and federal regulations. With the new transfer laws that will go into effect in March of 2024, this winter would be a great time to buy and sell.
